SUBJECT: Supplemental Educational Services (SES) Providers

Please consider this as notification of a Request for Applications (RFA) for the 21012-2013 funding cycle of the federal Title I, Part A, Supplemental Educational Services (SES) Providers List. As part of the reauthorization of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA), any school which is in its second year of school improvement must offer supplemental services to the parents of eligible children who attend that school. In order to carry out this provision “any local educational agency (LEA) serving such school shall arrange for the provision of supplemental educational services to eligible children in the school from a ‘provider with a demonstrated record of effectiveness, that is selected by the parents and approved for that purpose by the State Educational Agency (SEA) in accordance with reasonable criteria,’ that the State educational agency shall adopt.” Please note that even if your organization is included on the State approved list, this does not guarantee that your services will be used.
