GEAR UP Abstract 2010-2011**

Clark High School serves approximately 2,700 students: 51.3% male, 48.7% female. The diverse population includes 0.4% American Indian/Alaskan Native, 10.3% African American, 18.6% Asian/Pacific Islander, 52.1% Hispanic, and 18.6% Caucasian. Additionally, 22.4% of the population is identified as LEP, 7.3% IEP, and 46.8% as Free or Reduced Lunch program.

Clark is a comprehensive high school that includes three magnet programs. GEAR UP students are part of a smaller learning community specifically designed to meet the challenges of the Clark community. Clark encourages academic excellence through rigorous academic expectations built into the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Course standards. Honors, AP and career/technical classes provide opportunities for students to pursue personal interests and aptitudes. Nevada State GEAR UP will support campus programs through focused incentives and support for learning initiatives including after school tutoring and homework assistance. The Academic Plan that supports each student's education and career aspirations is reviewed annually with the assigned GEAR UP counselor. GEAR UP funds will allow students to take the AP tests and those who have achieved the scholarship GPA will take the PSAT or the ACT.

Parent events will emphasize financial as well as academic readiness for postsecondary options. Additionally, the Academic Plan will assure each student participates in a field trip to a NSHE campus program related to personal aptitudes and interests.
