

New Teacher Incentives (SB 511)

8/28/2015

- SB 511 and SB 515 (2015) provide \$10 million in each year of the current biennium for new teacher incentives at Title I and certain underperforming schools
- 3 districts not requesting 2015-2016 funding (*Douglas County; Eureka County; Storey County*)
- \$10,910,375 – initial request by ten districts
(*Carson City; Churchill; Clark; Elko; Humboldt; Lander; Lincoln; Lyon; Pershing; Washoe*)
- \$9,671,000 – allocated to ten districts at 7/23/2015 Board meeting, based on \$4,000/per expected new teacher (*\$329,000 remaining*)
- 4 districts requested extended deadline (*Esmeralda; Mineral; Nye; White Pine*)
