Public Hearing and possible adoption of Proposed Amendments R 136 - 15, NAC Chapter 391, to provide a definition of "moral turpitude" for the purpose of implementing NRS 391.033 (Issuance of licenses; fingerprinting of applicants; provisional licensure authorized), NRS 391.100 (Employment of personnel by trustees; certain teachers and paraprofessionals required to possess qualifications prescribed by federal law; school district prohibited from requiring licensed employees on approved leave to submit fingerprints as condition of return to employment; exception; school police officers; contract for police services), NRS 391.31297 (Grounds for suspension, demotion, dismissal and refusal to reemploy teachers and administrators; consideration of evaluations and standards of performance), NRS 391.314 (Suspension of licensed employee; dismissal proceedings; reinstatement; salary during suspension or dismissal proceedings; forfeiture of right of employment for certain offenses; period of suspension), NRS 391.330 (Grounds for suspension or revocation of license), NRS 392A.080 (Composition of governing body; appointment; terms; powers; quarterly meetings), and NRS 392A.107 (Fingerprinting of nonlicensed applicants for employment; review of criminal history by Superintendent of Public
