



**Special – Specific to the Grade Level of the Base Teaching License  
Endorsement to Teach a Program of Bilingual Education**

**[NAC 391.242](#)**

**To receive an endorsement to teach bilingual education, a person must:**

1. Have a Bachelor’s degree with a major in bilingual education, and
2. Hold an elementary, middle school/junior high, secondary or special license and have completed:
  - A. A bilingual program of preparation for teaching pupils who are identified as having limited proficiency in English which has been approved by the Board; or
  - B. At least twelve (12) semester credits in a course of study which includes Theories for the Acquisition of a Second Language and course work in at least three (3) of the following:
    - i. Methods of teaching language arts or reading in the native language
    - ii. Methods of teaching math, science and social studies in the native language
    - iii. Testing and evaluating pupils of a second language in English and the native language
    - iv. Development of curriculum, materials and teaching methods for bilingual education
    - v. Native language and culture; or
    - vi. Bilingual education, history, philosophy and theory
