



Special – Specific to the Grade Level of the Base Teaching License Endorsement to Teach Computer-Based Applications

NAC 391.202

To receive an endorsement to teach computer-based applications, a person must:

1. Hold an elementary, middle school/junior high, secondary or special license and have completed:
2. A program which has been approved by the Board for teaching computer-based applications; or
3. Twelve (12) semester credits which must include the following:
 - A. Educational issues relating to computers; and
 - B. Methods for teaching the integration of technology with curriculum; and
 - C. Methods for teaching computer applications or instruction in at least three (3) of the following application packages:
 - i. Productivity tools such as word processing, databases and spreadsheets
 - ii. Communication tools
 - iii. Research tools
 - iv. Multimedia tools; or
 - v. Other applications approved by the Board.
