



# Nevada School Performance Framework

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## Overview

Developed by Nevada stakeholders, and informed by State and Federal policy, the Nevada School Performance Framework (NSPF) is an annual summary of school performance. Unique for each school level, the NSPF is made up of a series of Performance Indicators and Measures. Performance Indicators are broad general categories within the framework, while Measures are the building blocks of a Performance Indicator. Schools earn points based on their performance on each measure. These points are added together to produce an overall summative rating, or a Star Rating.

## Questions and Answers

### What is a Star Rating?

Star Ratings are descriptors of how a school is performing based on the results of the Performance Indicators in the framework. A Five Star rating recognizes a **superior** school that exceeds expectations for all students and subgroups on every indicator category with little or no exception. A Four Star rating recognizes a **commendable** school that has performed well for all students and subgroups. A Three Star rating identifies an **adequate** school that has met the state's standard for performance. A Two Star rating identifies a school that has **partially met** the state's standard for performance. A One Star rating identifies a school that has **not met** the state's standard for performance.

### Who is included in the NSPF?

The minimum number (n-size) of student records required for calculation in each measure of the NSPF is ten (10). In order for student results to be included, the student must be continuously enrolled at a school on or before validation day (the first instructional day in October) until the start of the state assessment window. All measures for all school levels in the NSPF will be disaggregated by three special populations (English Learner, Economically Disadvantaged and students with an Individualized Education Program) and seven ethnicity populations (African American, Asian, American Indian/Alaskan Native, Hispanic, Pacific Islander, Caucasian, and Multi-Race).


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
