


Adult high school programs are operated by 14 local school districts in Nevada

Adult Learner Enrollment





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Adult High Schools provide opportunities for Nevada adults to:

Return to school and earn their High School Equivalency Certificate or Adult High School Diploma

- ❖ **Get a job**
- ❖ **Keep their job**
- ❖ **Get off welfare**
- ❖ **Transfer to college or other career and technical training programs**
- ❖ **Learn English language skills, understand US culture, and participate in society**
- ❖ **Help their children with homework and be successful in school**
- ❖ **Read and follow healthcare instructions**

Adult High Schools Provide Diplomas and Certificates

- ❖ 1,547 diplomas were awarded by Adult High School Programs in 2015-2016
- ❖ 1,768 learners earned a Certificate of High School Equivalency (GED®, HiSET®, or TASC™)
- ❖ 9,446 high school credits were awarded to learners who were previously considered “non-graduates” or “drop-outs”.
- ❖ 1,198 Vocational certificates earned
