

## Staffing Options for PD Evaluation

#### I. Professional Development Committees

*Definition:* Groups sanctioned by the State to review coursework and professional development activities proposed and completed by educators to determine if state certification and licensure requirements have been met.

*Purpose:*

1. The primary responsibility of the Local Professional Development Committee (LPDC) is to review educators' Individual Professional Development Plans (IPDPs) and ensure that the identified goals and strategies are relevant to the needs of the district, the school, the students and the educator.
2. LPDCs are responsible for reviewing and approving Individual Professional Development Plans (IPDPs), coursework and other professional development activities that educators propose to complete for the purpose of license renewal.

#### I. Professional Development Committees

*Definition:* The Professional Development and Associated Compensation Committee has reviewed research in the area of effective professional development and will make recommendations on the types of professional development and professional responsibilities which will qualify educators for additional salary increments. Efforts are designed to ensure that both professional development and professional responsibilities enhance student learning and continuously improve the quality of teaching and educational leadership in Delaware's schools.

*Purpose:*

1. This committee is charged with reviewing current practice and analyzing work done by predecessor committees in areas related to professional development and associated compensation.
2. The PDACC is also responsible for identifying national and regional trends which impact of these issues, and recommending to the Professional Standards Board.
