 - The qualifications for licensure of administrators prescribed by the Commission on Professional Standards in Education pursuant to NRS 391.019;
 - The recruitment of administrators;
 - Professional development for administrators, as provided by a school district, regional training program for the professional development of teachers and administrators or other entity; and
 - The compensation of administrators pursuant to chapter 288 of NRS and any program of performance pay and enhanced compensation established by a school district pursuant to NRS 391A.450.
