RE: Q4 FY17 CSR Variance Report

Introduction

Pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 388.700(5), the State Board of Education is required to submit a quarterly Class-Size Reduction (CSR) report to the Interim Finance Committee (IFC) on each variance requested by a school district during the preceding quarter. The report must include an identification of the elementary school for which a variance was granted, as well as the specific justification for the variance.

Executive Summary

- The number of underperforming 1- & 2-Star (District) schools with variances is 44 out of 98. This is a decrease from 49 schools last quarter. There were 61 classroom variances from those 44 schools.
- Total classroom variances totaled 691, compared to 666 in Q1, which is a 3.7% increase. 255 schools reported variances in the first quarter and 270 schools in the fourth quarter. This is a 5.5% increase.
- Otherwise, there are no material changes since the prior quarter.

Scope of Report

Attached is the report of variances for the 4th quarter of Fiscal Year (FY) 2017. The report provides a summary of variance requests by school district and charter school and specific variance information by school. For each variance request, the following information is presented for each school:

- There are two types of CSR programs funded in Nevada:
 1. Regular CSR: Pupil-teacher ratio; Kindergarten – 21:1; Grades 1 and 2 – 17:1; and Grade 3 – 20:1. This program is currently funded through Sections 15 and 16 of S.B. 515.

2. Alternative CSR: School districts which are located in a county whose population is less than 100,000 may select the Alternative CSR program which provides flexibility in implementing pupil-teacher ratios in grades 1 through 6 for - Kindergarten – 21:1; Grades 1 through 3 – 22:1 and Grades 4 through 6 – 25:1. This program is authorized through NRS 388.720.

- Demographic Data: Low Income (percent of student population eligible for free and reduced priced lunch) and the percent of the student population who are English Learners (EL).
- Achievement Data: Star Rating Pursuant to the Nevada School Performance Framework; and
- Student counts over and under the approved ratios, by grade.

Statewide Summary of Variances & Justifications

Variance requests have three standard potential justifications: Funding Limitations, Difficulty Hiring Teachers, and Facility Limitations. Any or all of these justifications are accepted, as well as Other (which represents about 2% of all variance requests statewide).

- 75% of the schools reported all three justifications for variance reasons. The second most reported pairing of justifications was hiring and funding limitations, which accounted for 15.65% of the requests.
- Funding limitations were reported in 96% of the justifications, hiring was reported in 93% of the justifications and facility limitations in 76%.
- Other accounted for 4% of the justifications.

School Level Variances Analysis:

There were 270 out of 358 schools with variances in the fourth quarter compared to 255, which is a 5.9% increase over the full year. While total variances by grade increased by 3.7% from 666 to 691. There were 46 out of 96 underperforming schools with a 64 total variances; compared to 31 schools and 44 variances in first quarter of FY17. This represents a 48% increase in the number of underperforming schools with variances.

The attached variance report is sorted by school district; the red boxes identify classrooms over the approved class size ratio. The number inside the shaded box indicates the number of students under (negative value) or over (positive value) the allowed ratio.

Kindergarten Variance Requests:

Pursuant to Section 32 of S.B. 515, the recommended pupil-teacher ratio for kindergarten is 21:1. If classroom ratios exceed 21:1, the superintendent of the school district may approve variances up to 25:1. Kindergarten classrooms may not exceed a 25:1 ratio, except for remote and rural schools with an approved plan of corrective action. 7 schools were over the 25 to1 allowable ratios and 139 total schools were above a 21 to 1 ratio.

CONCLUDING REMARKS

The Department of Education is committed to working with the State Board, districts, and charter schools to decrease the number of variance requests, particularly in underperforming schools.
