- Foster positive relationships and interactions.

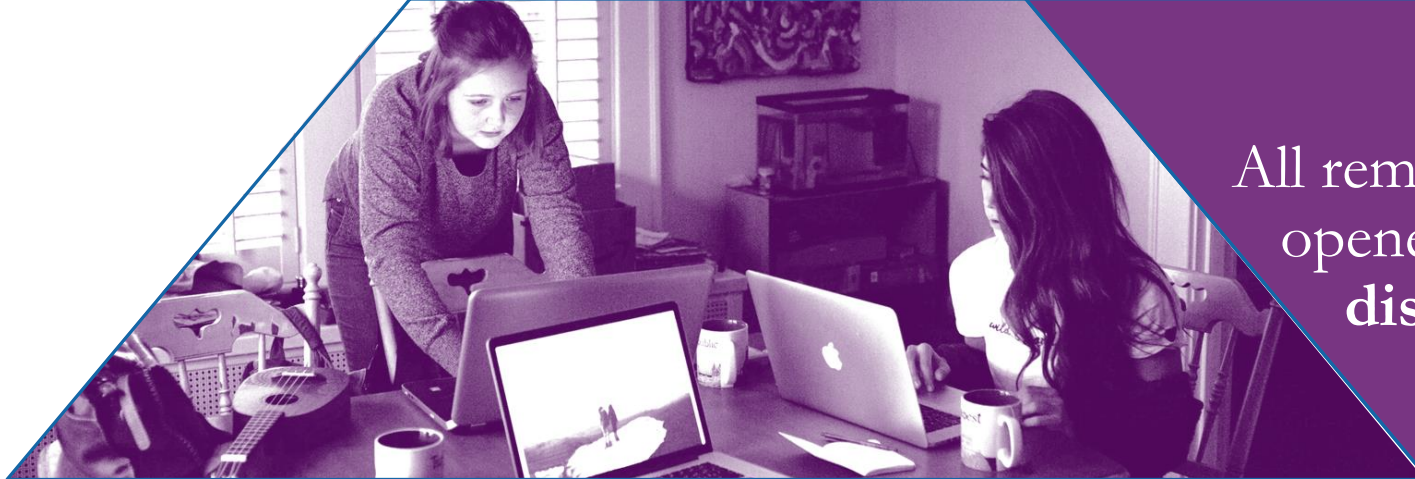
CCSD SCHOOLS ARE OPENING IN ALL THREE INSTRUCTIONAL DELIVERY MODELS

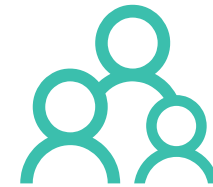

On-Site Meal Distribution

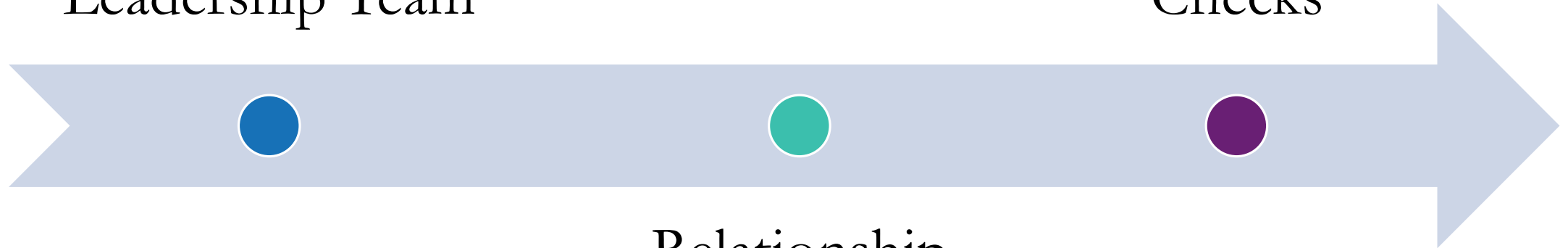
Meal services will be offered at designated school sites from Monday through Friday, excluding any school holidays identified in the school calendar.
