- 7. NEPF Educational Practice Category Weightings for Personnel for whom Student Performance Data must not be used pursuant to NRS 391.695 and NRS 391.715.** *(Information/Discussion/Possible Action)* Kathleen Galland-Collins, NDE Education Programs Supervisor  
NRS 391.695 and 391.715 require that the evaluation of a probationary teacher or administrator in his or her initial year of employment as a probationary teacher or administrator must NOT include student performance data. It also stipulates that the evaluation of teachers and administrators at a school designated as a turnaround school according to NRS 388G.400, must NOT include student performance data for the first and second years after the school has been designated as a turnaround school. Members will discuss and determine the Instructional Practice/Instructional Leadership Practice and Professional Responsibilities Domain weights to be used for such personnel.
