Passage of SB 497 during the 2017 legislative session requires the Department to develop an Advisory Task Force on School Leader Management; requiring the Task Force to conduct a study concerning the evaluation, preparation, licensure, recruitment, professional development and compensation of educational

administrators; and providing other matters properly relating thereto. Members will appoint a current Council member to serve on this advisory task force.
