

Regulation Revisions on Work-based Learning

NAC 389.825 Private or Public Internships becomes about Work-based Learning in a broader sense and clarifies application and reporting requirements for work-based learning that is credit bearing. Defines the length of work-based learning for credit requirements and requirements for experiences over 30 hours.

NAC 389.XXX Defines Work-based Learning and describes requirements for a district designated coordinator

NAC 389.562 Career and technical education work experience in cooperation with employers becomes specific to paid work experience and apprenticeships tied to a CTE program of study. Duties of the student, teacher, coordinator (added) and employer are updated.

NAC 387.306 Proposing for elimination of this regulation. Attendance is addressed in the regulation changes above. Duplicated and outdated.

NAC 389.644 to 389.650 Updates the 1987 language for programs of work and study designed for students at risk of dropping out. This regulation applies to students who are not CTE students nor participating in a WBL that is tied to a career interest. These are students who because of special circumstances just need to work and get credit for doing so. Districts said there is still a need and place for this type of work and study.
