**Current *Standard* High School Diploma:**

- 15 units of credit for the required courses
- 7 ½ units of credit for elective courses
- 22 ½ units of credit total

**Current *Advanced* High School Diploma:**

- Meet criteria per NRS 389.805 (CCR assessment; EOC, no longer applicable)
- 18 units of credit for the required courses
- 6 units of credit for elective courses
- 24 units of credit total
- Maintained at least a 3.25 GPA (on a 4.0 grading scale, weighted or unweighted) for all units of credit applicable toward graduation)

- 17 units of credit for the required courses
- 6 units of credit for elective courses
- 23 units of credit total

**NOTES:**

- No criteria per NRS 389.805; disallowed for the *Standard* High School Diploma, per A.B. 7, Section 53(3)(a); *may* be used with the College and Career Ready Diploma
- No GPA requirement for the PROPOSED *Standard* High School Diploma
- Mirrors the academic requirements of the *Advanced* High School Diploma, except for:
  - One less unit of credit; recommended per the SBE High School Graduation Committee, August 2017.
  - One *toggle* unit of credit for either *mathematics* or *science*
