Jayne Malorni, Education Programs Professional explained that the financial literacy standards cover the core concepts that every student should master to become financially knowledgeable and successful. The financial literacy standards also include the practice that students need to be actively engaged in as they learn, adapt and employ these standards as they become college and career ready. All curricular decisions that districts, schools and teachers make regarding financial literacy education for every K-12 student in Nevada should be based on these standards.

The financial literacy standards are a strand contained in the K-12 Nevada Academic content standards for Social Studies. These changes are necessary to update the curriculum in the ever changing 21<sup>st</sup> century for stakeholders. Those changes include the following:

1. The creation of financial literacy specific standards in five core areas: financial decision-making, savings and spending, credit and debit, insurance, investing and risk and college and career readiness.
2. Grade level financial literacy standards for 3-5 grade banded standards for 6-8 and 9-12 for each of the core areas.
