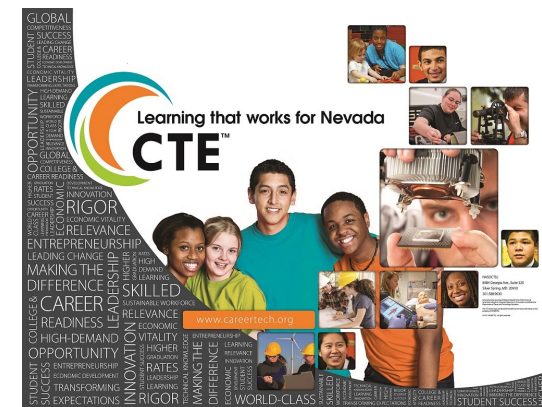

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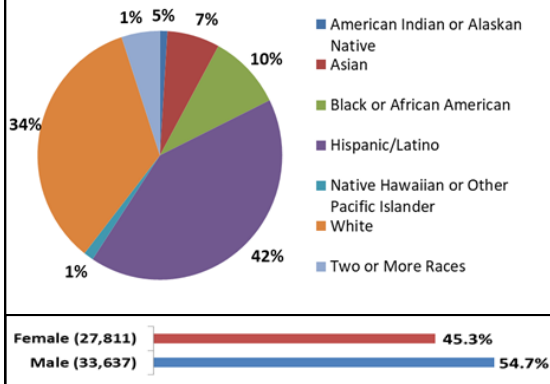

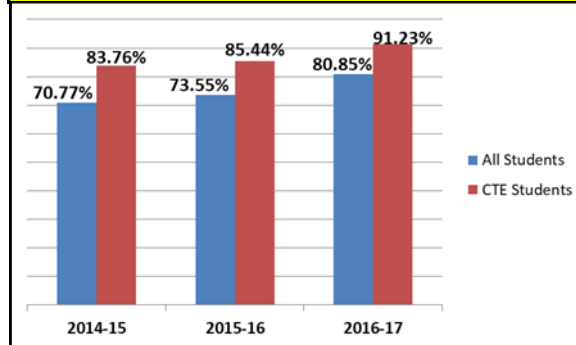

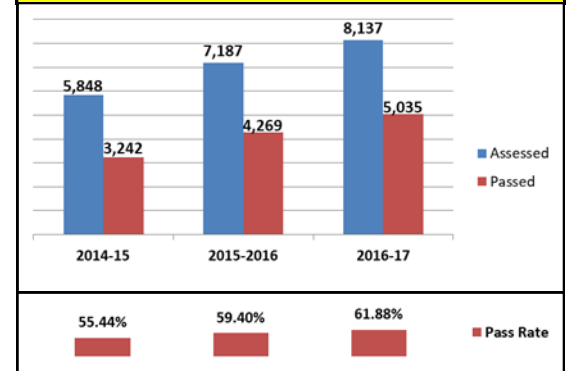
CTE Secondary Demographics 2016 –17 Unduplicated Count (61,448)



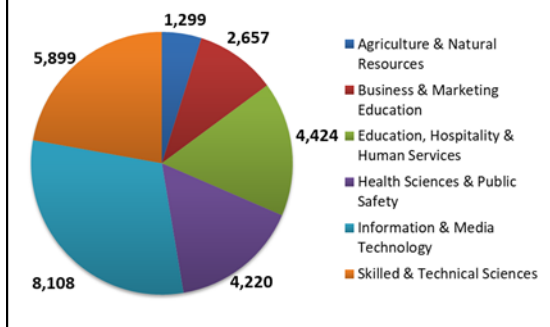
CTE Secondary Cohort Graduation Rate Comparison



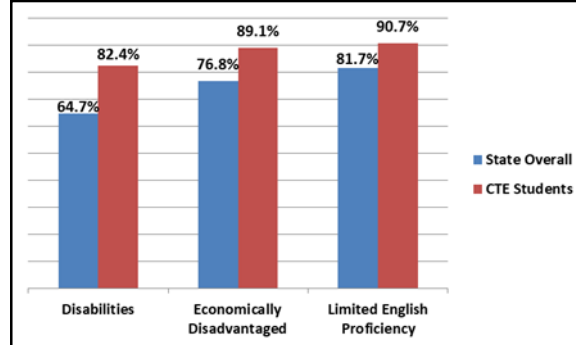
CTE End of Program Technical Assessment Results



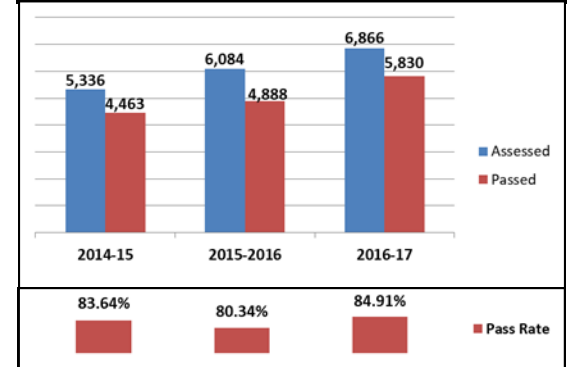
CTE Secondary Concentrators by Program Area 2016 –17 (26,607)



CTE Secondary Graduation by Special Population

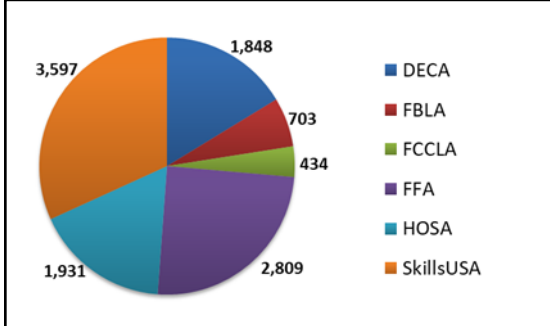


CTE Workplace Readiness Skills Assessment Results

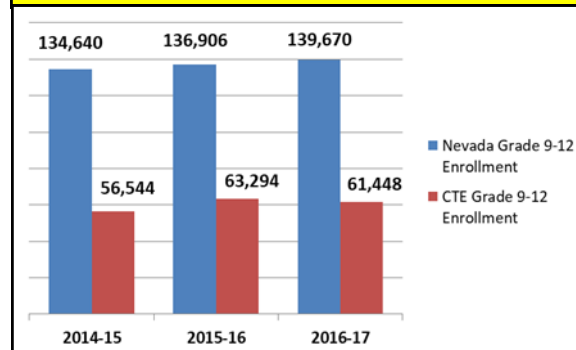
