**SUBJECT:** Public Comment on Perkins V State Determined Performance Levels for  
Postsecondary Performance Indicators

Under section 113 of the *Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Act* (Perkins V), the Nevada Department of Education is instructed to collaborate with educational stakeholders and members of the public to set State Determined Performance Levels (SDPLs) for the required postsecondary Performance Indicators. This process was originally carried out via meetings of the CTE Accountability and Performance Indicators workgroup, which met in the Spring and Summer of 2019, and the results of their work were approved by the Perkins V Governance Board and included in Nevada's State Plan. The State Plan was posted for public comment, approved by the State Board of Education, and provided for review to the office of Governor Sisolak.

Due to new data being provided after the 2018-19 school year, a Postsecondary SDPL Workgroup met on April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 to discuss revisions to those SDPLs. The results of those discussions were new SDPLs for FY 2022/23 for 1P1, revisions to indicator 2P1, and an ongoing discussion regarding 3P1. The proposed revisions can be found in the table below:
