Nevada's Read by Grade 3 Program

Q1. Will a Word version of the RFA be posted so that pages needing a signature may be uploaded?)

A1. A Word version of the RFA has been posted on the Grant Info. webpage on the NDE website on the Grant Information link.

Q2. Is Section A – The Local Literacy Plan part of the 20 page count on the narrative?

A2. The Local Literacy Plan (Appendix A) does not count as part of the 20-page requirement for the narrative. (None of the Appendices do).

Q3. Is Section B - Evidence of Need and Eligibility part of the 20 page count on the narrative?

A3. Yes it is.

Q4. Is the Addendum part of the 20 page limit? If not, is there a page limit on the addendum?

A4. Yes, the Innovations Addendum is part of the 20-page limit of the Narrative Section of the application.

Q5. Can you only pick one topic to write to in the Addendum? Or may an applicant address more than one topic?

A5. Per the topic . . . please note that these are listed as “recommended” . . . feel free to address one or more or even a different topic that you perceive effectively identifies a “plan of innovation”.

Q6. If we were an awarded Phase II program, how are we to represent our scores on the MPO table?

A6. Please see page 17 of the RFA. It notes that Phase II programs are only required to complete the red rows on the MPO table and to add as an Appendix their Final Data Submission Tool that was submitted in June. Some programs are choosing to complete the table with all of the data. That will be fine.

Q7. Do we just list MAP as our assessment on the chart?

A7. If your Phase II program utilized the K-3 MAP assessment then your final Data Submission Tool will represent MAP data.

If you were not a Phase II program, you will need to note the data from the assessment that you used (that was approved on the policy list for 2015).

Q8. What do we do with the column for Grade 3?

A8. If you used MAP or another K-3 assessment tool for Grade 3 please represent those scores and the 3rd Grade SBAC scores. Simply add both.

Q9. Is there a scoring rubric for Addendum?

A9. The Addendum points total 5 points. They are added as a “bonus”. There is no specific rubric for these points.

Q10. Can you define what is meant by “innovative”?
