If there are 10 or more employees, the school must have a written safety program.

If there are 25 or more employees, the school must have a safety committee.

School vehicles must be inspected by ~ **NEVADA DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, COMMERCIAL ENFORCEMENT DIVISION – UNDER THE NEVADA HIGHWAY PATROL**. There is no charge for this.
